Breastfeeding is the gold standard of infant nutrition. The unique features in breast milk which make it superior to formula include amino acids and immunglobulins. Amino acids and omega fatty acids stimulate brain growth and immunoglobulins protect the newborn against infections.

There are many other advantages for newborns who are breastfed; some of them are:

- Easier than formula to digest (less constipation. diarrhea, and spitting up)
- Decreases the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome
- Decreases the risk of allergies (to develop toward milk/foods/environmental)

There are also many advantages for mothers who breastfeed their newborns; some of them are:

- Cost (much cheaper to consume calories to produce breastmilk than to purchase formula)
- Decreases the risk of developing breast cancer or osteoporosis in life
- No preparation (always mixed right, fewer dirty bottles, and always ready in easy to-go containers)
